Dear Mr. Huie:

Per your email dated 9-8-2003, [REDACTED] File Number 0058-EX-ML-2003.

We would also appreciate it if you could change the Applicant/Licensee's name from "Southwestern Bell Technology Resources" to its new name "SBC Laboratories" (which has become effective since June 2003).

SBC Laboratories is requesting that the frequency bands 698-746 MHz, 747-762 MHz, 777-792 MHz, 1670-1675 MHz, 2305-2320 MHz, and 2345-2360 MHz be added to its existing experimental license.

This request is made in order to allow SBC to conduct technology feasibility studies, conduct RF propagation studies, and test equipment performance in the allocated WCS band, and the UHF bands to be auctioned (or considered to be auctioned) by the FCC.

All tests will be of non-commercial nature and conducted -- in accordance with all FCC rules and regulations -- to assess system potential and performance characteristics before offering commercial services and products providing broadband wireless access.
