NAME SEIKO TELECOMMUNICATION SYSTEMS, INC.

Special Temporary Authority is hereby granted to operate the radio transmitting apparatus described below:

96.7	1 (ERP)	180KF8E

Special Conditions:

1. This authority is conditioned upon the lack of objectionable interference to Stations KEGF (FM) and KSCS (FM), both located in Fort Worth, TX, or any authorized radio services. If any interference is caused by the experimental operation, the permittee, upon notification by the FCC that such interference has occurred, must immediately cease operation or reduce power to such a level that will eliminate all interference. The permittee must submit written notification to the Commission of any such interference and explain what steps were taken to eliminate it.

2. The permittee must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency radiation in excess of FCC guidelines.

This special temporary authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This special temporary authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Dear Mr. Secretary:

Seiko Telecommunication Systems, Inc. ("STS"), hereby requests special temporary authority ("STA") to operate a one-watt FM transmitter on 96.7 MHz either inside the ¹Dallas, Texas Convention Center or inside the Loews ²Anatole Hotel in Dallas, from August 30-September 15, 1993, in conjunction with the National Association of Broadcasters' Radio Show, in accordance with the attached technical specifications. Transmissions made pursuant to the requested STA will be of limited duration and will be conducted for product demonstration purposes only. Attached hereto is a Certification pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853a.

The need for the STA to cover two sites arises from STS's desire to have the flexibility to provide demonstrations at either locale, depending on demand. STS will not operate from both sites simultaneously.

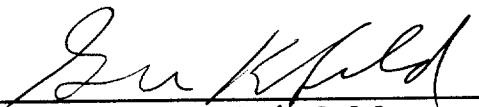

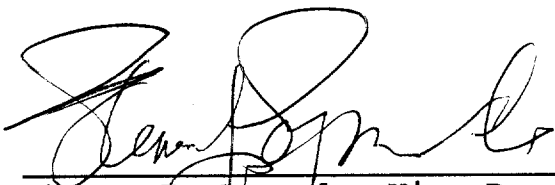
