This coordination letter does not grant the recipient any priority or interference protection with regard to licensees of established radio services. Irrespective of this coordination letter, recipient may need to cooperate with other Part 5 experimental license recipients, whether recipients of special temporary authority or long-term Part 5 licenses, in order to successfully use and share the spectrum.
