In response to your correspondence to BAE Systems' Mr. Mike Matsick dated May 2, 2007 (Ref. No. 4920) and previous discussions with undersigned counsel, this is to advise you of the following:

1. AFTRCC has completed its coordination of the above-referenced application. A scan of the AFTRCC report indicating no objection to the proposed operations was submitted to you by e-mail today. Because the ELS Reply to Correspondence link does not permit the attachment of documents, it is respectfully requested that the scan of the AFTRCC Report that was submitted by e-mail today be associated with this submission.

2. The applicant has not yet received word back from the FAA regarding its completion of FAA coordination for the application. As you can see from the e-mail chain below, the applicant requested FAA coordination immediately upon receipt of the Commission's letter, and has dutifully followed-up with FAA to determine the status of the coordination. However, to date, the applicant has not received confirmation from the FAA that coordination has been completed. Because this delay is completely outside the applicant's control, it is respectfully requested that the Commission allow some additional time for it to obtain confirmation from the FAA that its coordination has been completed. At your convenience, it would be greatly appreciated if you could provide confirmation that additional time has been granted to permit BAE Systems to obtain confirmation from the FAA that coordination has been completed.
