Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee must coordinate operations with the appropriate public safety frequency coordinator or all of the public safety licensees using the public safety frequencies requested in the application.
- (4) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by DARPA Contract No. W911NF-18-C-0027. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (5) Prior to commencing any operations in the frequencies below, Shared Spectrum Company must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
 - Mobile Service licensees in 454 MHz/459 MHz
 - General Aviation Air-Ground Service in 454 MHz/459 MHz
- (6) Shared Spectrum Company shall coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator in each proposed area prior to operation in the proposed frequency bands.
- (7) During transmission, aircraft shall not exceed the altitude of 328 feet AGL.
