Siemens ICM is a manufacturer/developer of GSM equipment that is provided to the PCS cell phone providers. This equipment is used to transmit voice and data from one subscriber to another. Siemens ICM equipment transmits in the United States on 1900 Mhz frequency. Siemens ICM has a nationwide experimental license to transmit on this frequency (File Number 0276-EX-RR-2000 and Call sign number WA2XDJ).

Presently we are in the process of testing Siemens ICM equipment to transmit on 850 Mhz to provide this technology to our perspective customers. Sites that will transmit on this frequency will be deployed all over the United States. Our test lab is situated in Boca Raton, Florida and most of the testing will be carried out at that facility. However, our Customers are requesting that we must provide field trials prior to the commitments and commercial deployment, hence we require a nationwide license.
