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Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) All customers participating in the experiment shall be informed that this operation is for experimental purposes only and can be cancelled at any time.
- (5) Prior to equipment authorization or a determination of compliance, the device must be accompanied by a conspicuous notice worded as follows: "This device has not been authorized as required by the rules of the Federal Communications Commission. This device is not, and may not be, offered for sale or lease, or sold or leased, until authorization is obtained."
- (6) Operation is subject prior coordination with fixed microwave service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d).
- (7) Licensee is required to file a PROGRESS REPORT every 6 months from the date of grant. This progress report shall be filed with Federal Communications Commission; Experimental Licensing Branch, MS 1300E1; 445 12 Street, S.W.; Washington, DC 20554.
- (8) This license SUPERSEDES the previously issued license with the same call sign and file number: adds the scope of service 5.3 (j), a condition to inform participating customers and a condition to label equipment with a conspicuous notice.
