SkyTel Corp.
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The purpose of this program is to design, optimize, and test equipment for wireless broadband networks in the new 3650 MHz to 3700 MHz frequency allocation from all non-MCI vendors before commercial deployment. The resulting systems will integrate data, video feeds, and voice-over-IP capabilities, which will then be made available to third-party purchasers, who will license and assume control of the systems. In some cases, this equipment may not be type accepted by the respective manufacturers during these tests.

SkyTel is making the instant request because, as of the date of filing, commercially licensed spectrum in this band is not yet available. SkyTel anticipates applying for such licenses when they become available, and requests this experimental license in order to begin research and development of these systems.

There are no concerns about interference with incumbents, as the Commission's databases reveal no existing licenses in this band within the entire state of Mississippi. Further, unless the Commission revises its rules relating to this spectrum, licenses within this band will be issued on a non-exclusive basis.

SkyTel believes that granting this request will serve the public interest. With this license, SkyTel will be able to develop and test wireless broadband systems in advance of commercial availability, so that the public can quickly enjoy the benefits anticipated by the Commission, such as efficient broadband access in rural areas and by wireless devices.
