Dear David,

Sprint PCS has evaluated SOMA Networks' request to temporarily operate within Sprint PCS' license frequency spectrum. Sprint PCS has set aside frequencies 1877.5 - 1881.25 MHz for mobile transmission and 1957.5 - 1961.25 MHz for base transmission in PCS frequency block B for temporary utilization by SOMA Networks. SOMA Networks will use these frequencies for the purpose of conducting BTS and handset equipment (the "Equipment") testing and demonstrations. SOMA Networks will obtain all necessary FCC approvals, if any, to use the frequencies as described herein.

Sprint PCS will be permitted by SOMA Networks, at Sprint PCS's request, to evaluate the operation of the Equipment to determine whether the operation of the Equipment hereunder causes harmful interference. It is SOMA Networks' responsibility to operate the Equipment within the cell site parameters set forth below. If harmful interference develops to Sprint PCS's operations or the operations of any other party, SOMA Networks shall cease transmissions, and transmissions shall not be resumed until it is certain that harmful interference will not be caused.

Sprint PCS will not be responsible for any harmful interference caused by SOMA Networks. SOMA Networks is responsible for, and it is SOMA Networks' duty to mitigate, any harmful interference it may cause; provided, however, SOMA Networks shall not be responsible for any harmful interference to the extent arising from Sprint PCS' actions or omissions. SOMA Networks and Sprint PCS shall promptly notify each other of any allegations of harmful interference. Sprint PCS retains the right to suspend or revoke the utilization of the frequencies by SOMA Networks at any time, with or without cause.

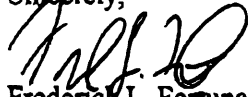
RF radiation on the assigned carriers will be permitted for a period no longer than six (6) months commencing on Thursday, December 20, 2001 and ending on Thursday, June 20, 2002. SOMA Networks is to notify the following Sprint PCS employee prior to cell activation: Dave Kirk @ (913) 315-2639.

- Antenna Height: 30.48 m [100 feet]
- EIRP: 57 dBm 306 W (ERP)
