This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Licensee shall secure consents from the Advance Wireless Service licensees prior to operation in 1710-1780 MHz band.
- (4) Licensee shall coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator prior to operation in 2402-2480 MHz and 2412-2462 MHz bands.
- (5) Licensee shall coordinate with affected Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 27.5-28.35 GHz, 2402-2480 MHz and 2412-2462 MHz bands.
- (6) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
