To whom it may concern:

Pursuant to Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's rules, Sony Mobile Communications Inc. ("Sony Mobile") respectfully requests confidential treatment for portions of its Application for Special Temporary Authority ("STA"), to which this letter is submitted as an exhibit, as more fully described below.

As required by Section 0.459(b) of the Commission's rules, Sony submits the following statement of the reasons for withholding the materials from public inspection:

(1) Identification of the specific information for which confidential treatment is sought

Sony Mobile requests confidential treatment, to the extent permissible, for the information in the document titled "Exhibit," which is being submitted to this file on January 29, 2020.

(2) Identification of the Commission proceeding in which the information was submitted or a description of the circumstances giving rise to the submission

Sony Mobile is submitting this information in connection with a request for special temporary authority ("STA") to operate certain experimental wireless equipment.

(3) Explanation of the degree to which the information is commercial or financial, or contains a trade secret or is privileged

This exhibit includes commercial information and trade secrets relating to the testing of experimental equipment.

(4) Explanation of the degree to which the information concerns a service that is subject to competition

Sony Mobile believes that there will be a robust market in the future for the equipment under test.

(5) Explanation of how disclosure of the information could result in substantial competitive harm

Disclosure of this confidential material could result in substantial competitive harm because it includes technical information and product plans for undisclosed products and services.

(6) Identification of any measures taken by the submitting party to prevent unauthorized disclosure

Sony Mobile uses all commercially reasonable methods to prevent unauthorized disclosure of its confidential material.

(7) Identification of whether the information is available to the public and the extent of any previous disclosure of the information to third parties

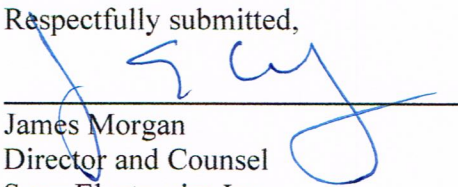
Except for its network service provider partner, this information has not previously been shared outside of Sony Mobile and its corporate affiliates, including to the public or to third parties.

(8) Justification of the period during which the submitting party asserts that material should not be available for public disclosure

Sony Mobile asks that this information remain confidential for a period of one year after the conclusion of the requested STA period, after which any potential for harm due to the disclosure of confidential and trade secret information will no longer exist.
