Message:

It is problematic for us to authorize operations nationwide for up to 500 undetermined locations. The application would need coordination with NTIA and the FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. It is unlikely that this coordination would be successful. The FCC would prefer to process an application which had a limited number of defined locations. For example, look at ARRL's experimental license WD2XSH for operations around 500 kHz. They started with 23 locations and modified it up to the current 42 locations. It is hard to understand why 500 locations would be necessary for propagation studies. Please address these concerns.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of May 05, 2015 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
