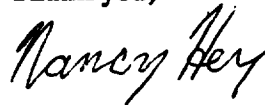

Section 5.55(d) of the FCC's Code of Federal Regulations states: "Unless otherwise directed by the Commission, each application for renewal of license shall be filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration date of the license to be renewed". 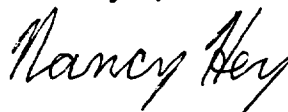
