

Exhibit 2: Request For Confidential Treatment

Pursuant to Section 0.459 of Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or the “Commission”) rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.459, Space Data Corporation (“Space Data”) requests that portions of the instant application for experimental authorization (the “Application”), be given confidential treatment. Specifically, Space Data requests that Exhibit 1 to the application be made confidential and not subject to public inspection. The information contained therein is confidential commercial information which is not customarily disclosed in the industry, and constitutes trade secrets and/or highly competitively sensitive business information. Given the highly competitive nature of the paging industry, disclosure of Space Data’s business plans and system design to the general public could greatly harm the business of the company. Moreover, the described system for providing service is the subject of a pending confidential patent application in the United States. Therefore, Space Data requests that the confidential Exhibit not be made routinely available for public inspection. In the event that the Commission determines that it will not be granted confidential treatment, Space Data requests that it immediately be so notified and that the Exhibit immediately be returned pursuant to Section 0.459(e) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. 0.459(e).
