Doug,

Sorry for the confusion. SpaceX plans to conduct its tests in US territorial waters. Specifically, it would like authority to operate between the 24NM Contiguous Zone with a boundary ID of B0128 and the 200NM Economic Exclusion Zone (EEZ) and Maritime Boundaries with IDs B0099 and B0492 as outlined by NOAA (<https://nauticalcharts.noaa.gov/data/us-maritime-limits-and-boundaries.html>). The ship will transit towards Boston coming around the coast of Nova Scotia so SpaceX will start the test as soon as we cross the boundary of B0099 or B0492. Put another way, the test will start at/near 42°47'N, -67°55'W as the ship passes from the EEZ to the Contiguous Zone starting when the ship enters US waters and continuing for approximately 50 km.
