**Subject:** 0830-EX-ST-2016 / Conditional Concurrence

NTIA conditionally concurs with the FCC STA request on behalf of Space Exploration Technologies Corp. (SpaceX) for Cape Canaveral AFS, Florida during the period 1 July 2016 thru 1 January 2017, under the following condition(s):

1. All SpaceX operations granted on an experimental basis shall be on an unprotected, non-interference basis to authorized federal stations.
2. All operations shall be limited to pre-launch check-out operations at Cape Canaveral Air Force Station (CCAFS) and experimental first-stage recovery operation (TC uplink from an onshore station at CCAFS), following a Falcon 9 launch from CCAFS with current launch planning date is NET 1 July 2016. This STA will expire upon completion of the experimental recovery operation or 1 January 2017, whichever occurs first
3. Sixty (60) days prior to transmitting (pre-launch check-out and experimental first-stage recovery operation) at CCAFS, Florida, SpaceX shall coordinate and schedule their operations with Range Scheduling, COMM: (321)- 853-5941, email: [1ropschd@us.af.mil](mailto:1ropschd@us.af.mil).
