

Details to support FCC STA application 0148-EX-ST-2014

During the IEEE DySPAN Event, and the preceeding WSRD Workshop a number or research projects will be demonstrated.

WSRD will be held at the NSF (4201 Wilson Blvd. Arlington VA 22230) on March 31 and IEEE DySPAN will be held at the Hilton Hotel (7920 Jones Branch Road Mclean VA 22102) on April 1-4 2014.

All these demonstrations will be held indoors using low power unlicensed or license exempt radio equipment.

While most of these demonstration devices will be cabled together up to 10 of them could be operating OTA.

The devices are all previously certified but because this is a research demonstration some of the radios may be being put to use in configurations not seen before.

This STA is applied for out of an abundance of caution to ensure that the devices are properly managed and that necessary precautions have been made to avoid interference and be able to identify the individuals and locations involved in the unlikely event that any interference is caused.
