Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Licensee will ensure transmit power levels do not exceed threshold of -120dBm RSRP outside of test facilities.
- (4) Licensee must prior coordinate testing with other authorized Band 14 operations. Failure to effectively coordinate shall result in FirstNet seeking immediate suspension of the experimental license by the FCC.

Special Conditions:

- (5) Licensee must accept interference from others operating in the band and must not cause interference to FirstNet operations or those approved to operate in Band 14 per license (i.e. AT&T testing or public safety entities authorized to operate on Band 14).
- (6) Licensee POC shall submit a "Stop Buzzer" contact to FirstNet at peter.tomczak@firstnet.gov upon authorization issuance with "kill switch" authority; license POC agrees to immediately cease operations on Band 14 if notified of any interference concerns until any issues are resolved.
- (7) Licensee agrees that this license may be subject to further review by the FCC and possible re-coordination with FirstNet.
