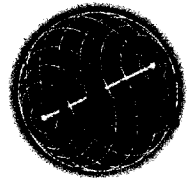

Dear Ms. Salas:

I am writing on behalf of Spike Technologies, Inc. ("Spike") in connection with the above-referenced application for experimental authorization that was filed on May 28, 1999. As the Commission is aware, Spike is a manufacturer of advanced, proprietary wireless telecommunications equipment for two-way applications.

It is our understanding that processing of the referenced application has encountered delay because some of the frequencies that Spike proposes to use in its program of experimentation are allocated to the U.S. government for defense purposes.

This letter is intended to clarify that Spike's experimental program is related solely to the development of equipment to be marketed and deployed in foreign markets where the requested frequencies (in and around the 3.5 GHz band) are allocated for private fixed communication services.
