This special temporary authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This special temporary authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Dear Sir or Madam:

On behalf of Spike Technologies, Inc. ("Spike"), this is to request immediate Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for a period of sixty (60) days to operate the experimental radio service described in Spike's pending application for experimental authorization, which was filed with the Commission on April 3, 1996 (copy attached hereto for convenience).¹

The reasons for this request are twofold. First, Spike has scheduled a demonstration of its equipment for Thursday, May 2, 1996. At that time, Spike plans to show potential business partners the dynamic capabilities of the transmission equipment described in its application. The STA will permit this process to begin without delays that could hinder its development efforts, and therefore grant would be consistent with the public interest.

Second, it is anticipated that this STA would be for a short period of time while its underlying application is processed. Spike understands that such processing, which must be coordinated between the Experimental Radio Branch and the Video Services Division, is underway.

Spike hereby certifies that neither Spike nor any of its officers, directors or shareholders have been subject to denial of

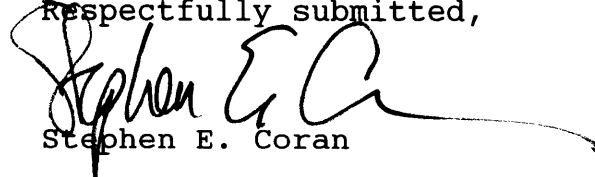

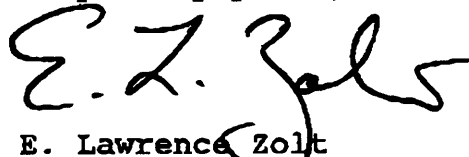
Dear Mr. Huie:
