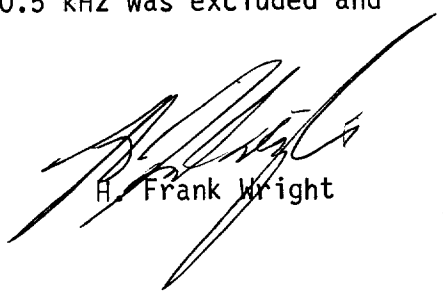

CONDITIONS

1. Operation shall be in accordance with the subject memorandum as submitted.
2. Operation shall be in accordance with the subject memorandum as modified.
3. Should harmful interference be caused by the use of any frequency authorized pursuant to this memorandum, it shall be the obligation of the licensee to co-operate to the fullest extent with the station interfered with and with the operating agencies and administrations concerned in the interest of alleviating the interference. Action taken shall be in accordance with applicable rules, regulations, treaties and established procedures.
4. This operation may be authorized for a temporary period. Any application for renewal of the authorization must be reCOORDINATED.
5. The operation may be authorized until the expiration date of the license or until the termination of the Government Contract and successive contracts for which it is issued, whichever is earlier. Successive Contracts shall be for Services which can be provided under the technical characteristics specified. Additionally, Successive Contract numbers shall be forwarded to the Commission in writing.
