Special Conditions:

- (1) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee must maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, sub-part Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3550-3700 MHz band.
- (4) Licensee shall consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz, and notify the registered users in the proposed area.
- (5) Licensee shall be aware that FSS earth stations are licensed above 3625 MHz and if any interference occurs, the experimental licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
