This request for information applies jointly to file numbers 0428-EX-ST-2014, 0429-EX-ST-2014, 0430-EX-ST-2014, 0432-EX-ST-2014 and 0434-EX-ST-2014.

There are 181 transmitters between these five applications. Experimental requests are supposed to be limited in scope to use the fewest transmitters necessary to complete the experimental program. Large numbers of transmitters draw concern to the Experimental Licensing Branch about system build-outs that may try to get around other Commission rules. What is the full intent of this program and what is trying to be accomplished that cannot be done under applicant's Part 101 license?

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of May 13, 2014 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.

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
