

REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION

On April 21, 2017, Straight Path Ventures, LLC (“SPV”) submitted an application to transfer control of its experimental station license to AT&T, Inc. (“AT&T”).^{1/} The transfer of control application was submitted pursuant to a Plan of Merger (the “Agreement”) between Straight Path Communications Inc. (“Straight Path Communications”), AT&T, and Switchback Merger Sub, Inc. (“Merger Sub”), a direct wholly-owned subsidiary of AT&T. On May 11, 2017, Straight Path Communications terminated the Agreement. SPV therefore requests withdrawal its transfer of control application.

^{1/} The call sign included in that application –WI2XTK – is currently the only experimental authorization issued to SPV. However, SPV submitted an application for a second experimental license, that had already been assigned the call sign WI2XTT that was pending at the time of the application. See Straight Path Ventures, LLC, *Application for New or Modified Radio Station Under Part 5 of FCC Rules*, File No. 0090-EX-CN-2017 (filed Feb. 13, 2017). Accordingly, Straight Path requested that any Commission action on the application for transfer of control include the authorization related to the pending request for the experimental radio service license.
