The FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau has licensees in the 2500-2690 MHz band that they want to protect from interference. They have requested that you get coordination consent from affected Broadband Radio Service (BRS) and Educational Broadband Service (EBS) licensees. Once you have uploaded coordination consent letters to your application, we will then grant a license for only those channels in the 2500-2690 MHz band that have been agreed to in the letters.

Your request for use of the 3500-3700 MHz is not affected by this coordination request.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application.
