Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee is required to ensure that trial devices are either rendered inoperable or retrieved by them from trial participants at the conclusion of the trial. Licensee is required to notify trial participants in advance that operation of the trial device is subject to this condition.
- (2) All customers participating in the experiment shall be informed that this operation is for experimental purposes only and can be cancelled at any time.
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Operations are on a non-interference basis (NIB) and shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
- (5) Licensee be aware that FSS earth stations are licensed above 3700 MHz and if any interference occurs, the experimental licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (6) Maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Subpart Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3550-3700 MHz band.
- (7) Consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic areas.
