Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Operation is NOT PERMITTED using the frequency band 14.47-14.5 GHz.
- (4) In accordance with Article 4.4 of the ITU Radio Regulations, the operations authorized herein shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from harmful interference caused by, a station operating in accordance with the provisions of the ITU Constitution, the ITU Convention, and the ITU Radio Regulations.
- (5) Operation is subject to prior coordination with all the respective satellite operators as necessary to minimize interference.

- (7) Operation is subject to prior coordination with NASA- White sands Center (WSC) is required at least 3 days in advance with the NASA-WSC POC as designated by the NASA/GSFC spectrum Manager, Scott Galbraith at 301-286-5089, VINCENT.S.GALBRAITH@NASA.GOV, for operations within 550km of TDRS ground Stations located at Blossom Point, MD or White Sands, NM.
- (8) Operation is NOT PERMITTED using the frequency band from 13.75-13.801 MHz.
