1. There are no emission and bandwidth data present in the application. You can use Parts 2.201 and 2.202 of the FCC's rules for guidance.
2. You are required to submit a narrative statement describing in detail the following:
 - (a) The complete program of research and experimentation proposed including description of equipment and theory of operation;
 - (b) The specific objectives sought to be accomplished;
 - (c) How the program of experimentation has a reasonable promise of contribution to the development, extension, expansion, or utilization of the radio art, or is along line not already investigated.
3. Is this for WiMAX use? If so, this is not in the approved U.S. WiMAX band. It is in a federal government band and will not be approved unless it is strictly for export purposes.
