SUPPLEMENTARY STATEMENT

Telephonics Corporation is a primary supplier of Interrogation Friend/Foe (IFF) and Air Traffic Control (ATC) equipment to United States Government Agencies and to more than 16 other countries. Telephonics customers for IFF and ATC equipment include: the U.S. Air force, U.S. Navy, and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). More than 500 systems have been sold to U.S. agencies. Internationally, more than 100 systems have been delivered to western and eastern Europe, the Far East and South America.

The transmitter to be used for experimentation is standard for use with the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Air Traffic Control Radar Beacon System (ATCRBS). The transmitters meet ICAO and FAA requirements, and transmit standard P1, P2, and P3 interrogation pulses. No experimentation is planned that deviates from these requirements.

The transmitter-receiver is used to supply live signals to the data acquisition, processing and display equipment for development, production acceptance test and demonstration purposes.

VERTICAL PROFILE

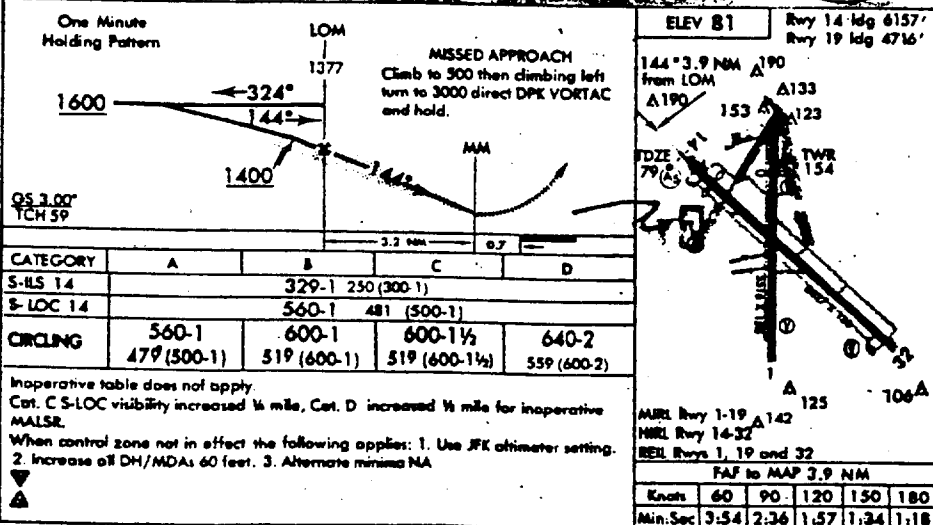
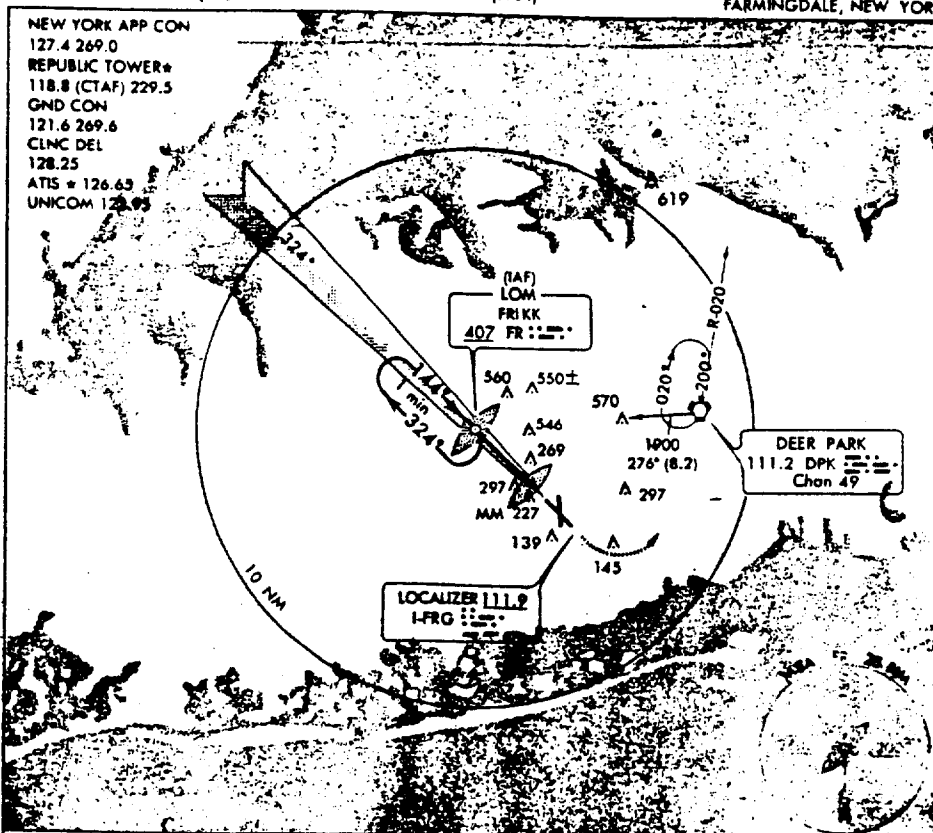

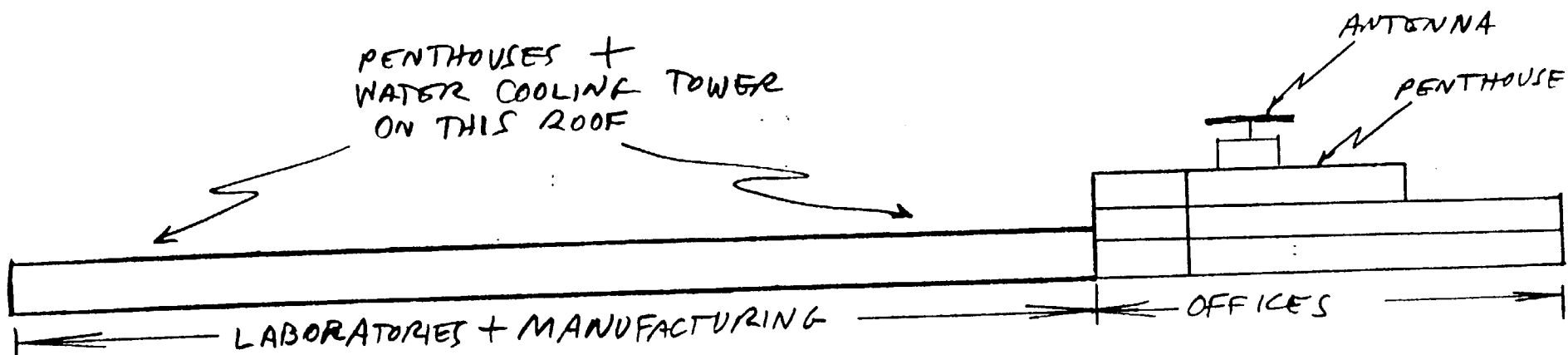
