We are developing a product to provide services to the frequent business traveler. As part of this product, software will be hosted on an airborne file server, to provide services to the frequent business traveler in flight. The airborne server will communicate to the ground over the existing aircraft communications systems like Inmarsat SatCom. Our airline customers will be operating worldwide.

As part of our product development activities, we will be conducting end-to-end system integration testing to ensure proper overall system operation. We plan to use ~~an~~ Inmarsat Mini-M ~~terminal~~ to represent the airborne Inmarsat SatCom system.

AND M4 TERMINALS

The AMSC satellite communication system does not support the worldwide connectivity we plan to offer when we enter service. Using an Inmarsat satellite terminal provides us with an environment that closely resembles the aeronautical signal in space and allows us to interface with the same Ground Earth Stations that we will be using in flight. This terminal will only be operated as a development tool and will have no commercial application.
