Description of experiment:

A \$9.8M USD Ceiling, 5-year sole source IDIQ contract has been awarded to Terma North America Inc. (TNA). IDIQ is a U.S. federal government contracting acronym meaning indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity. This is a type of contract that provides for an indefinite quantity of supplies or services during a fixed period of time by providing service support to the US Coast Guard and their 40 Terma Vessel Traffic Systems located in major ports and waterways across the U.S. The contract scope allows for life cycle maintenance & i.e., establishment of baseline configurations, scheduled grooms & preventative maintenance tasks & spare part procurement, procurement and installation services of new SCANTER radar systems, on-site casualty support, remote phone/email technical support, and 1 to 2 training courses per year.
