This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. - (1) This authorization is granted for the purpose of operating radio frequency devices (unintentional radiators) to determine quality, performance, and customer acceptance. These devices are not authorized under Part 15 of the FCC Rules at the present time and may not be marketed without FCC authorization. These devices may be marketed in limited quantities to entities involved in design and development as described in application for authorization.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
