1. There are no emission, modulating signal and necessary bandwidth present in the application. Review Parts 2.201 and 2.202 of the FCC's rules and then return to the filing site and use the "Amend/Complete Application" link to enter these data.
2. Submit a justification for a license term in excess of two years in accordance with Part 5.71 of the FCC's rules.
3. Submit a detailed narrative statement describing in detail the program of research and experimentation proposed, the specific objectives sought to be accomplished; and how the program of experimentation has a reasonable promise of contribution to the development, extension, or expansion, or utilization of the radio art, or is along lines not already investigated in accordance with Part 5.63(a) of the FCC's rules.
4. Submit a justification for the large number of units of equipment.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of October 31, 2006 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
