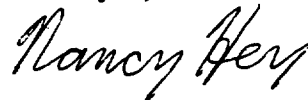

Dear Mr. Coughran:

Your request for license renewal of experimental radio station KA2XID is hereby returned to you, because it is past the due date for filing. Section 5.55(d) of the FCC's Code of Federal Regulations states: "Unless otherwise directed by the Commission, each application for renewal of license shall be filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration date of the license to be renewed. The license expiration date on station KA2XID was August 1, 1995. In order to obtain a valid license for your experimental radio station, you must reapply on a Form 442. Please submit the completed Form 442 through the Mellon Bank at P.O. Box 358320, Pittsburgh, PA 15251-5320. For your convenience, a copy of Form 442 is enclosed. Please include your previous call sign in your application.

Please be advised that as a state government agency, you are exempt from the \$45 filing fee. Therefore, the \$45 you sent with your form 405 will be refunded to you.
