Special Conditions:

- (6) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the US Marine Corps contract number N00019-08-D-0013. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
