This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) The potential for severe harmful interference to the Fixed Microwave Service operations in the adjacent bands is very high. The Boeing Company must successfully coordinate with the Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d) prior to operation in 20.2-21.2 GHz and 30-31 GHz bands.
- (4) The Boeing Company shall conduct all testing in accordance with the configuration and parameters that have been coordinated with Air Force (Jimmy Nguyen).
- (5) The Boeing Company shall limit operations to the emission designators listed and for the stated occupied bandwidth only. Occupied bandwidths that are less than the above emissions are not authorized.
- (6) All Boeing operations granted on an experimental basis (STA) shall be conducted on an unprotected, noninterference basis to authorized DoD stations.
- (7) This STA is limited to 6 months and is subject to re-coordination with AFSMO upon renewal.
- (8) As soon as possible, but no later than 3 business days prior to any planned testing, Boeing is required to provide Jimmy Nguyen (Email: jimmy.nguyen@us.af.mil, AFSMO) and Travis J. Inghram (Email: travis.j.ingram.civ@mail.mil, ARSTRAT) with the planned testing dates/duration and the stop buzzer POC for the testing. If planned testing is in conflict with DoD operations, additional evaluations and/or restrictions will be required.
