NAME THE BOEING COMPANY

This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Operation is NOT permitted using the following bands: 2850-3025 kHz, 3400-3500 kHz, 4650-4700 kHz, 5450-5680 kHz, 6525-6685 kHz, 8815-8965 kHz, 10005-10100 kHz, 11275-11400 kHz, 13260-13360 kHz, 17900-17970 kHz, and 21924-22000 kHz.
- (5) Operation must NOTCH OUT +/- 5 kHz of the following Standard Time Frequencies: 2500 kHz, 5000 kHz, 10000 kHz, 15000 kHz, 20000 kHz, and 25000 kHz.
- (6) The designated point-of-contact to terminate transmissions if interference occurs is Vincent Mancuso at 610-591-7215.
- (7) Boeing must notch out the following frequencies:
