Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) All aircrafts participating in this experiment shall be US-registered vessels.
- (5) The designated point-of-contact to terminate transmissions if interference occurs is Loren Ayotte at 425-647-5011.
- (6) Operation is NOT permitted on the frequency band 1755 MHz to 1850 MHz.
- (7) Licensee must get consent from the advanced wireless service licensees before experimental operation starts using the frequency 1710-1755 MHz.
