- (2) This frequency assignment in one of the bands 1435-1535 or 2310-2390 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the Mid-Atlantic Area Frequency Coordinator (AFC), Patuxent River, MD, who also coordinated it, as appropriate, with the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council. Use of this frequency under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the AFC as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (5) Operation must get consents from Educational Broadband Service, Broadband Radio Service, and Advanced Wireless Service licensees in the applicable geographic areas.
- (6) Operation is subject to prior coordination with Fixed Microwave licensees in the immediate test site areas to prevent possible interference with fixed point to point paths and with possible Temporary Fixed/Mobile point-to-point paths.
- (7) Operation is NOT PERMITTED in the frequency bands: 1559-1563 MHz, 1588-1610 MHz, 4200-4400 MHz, 5600-5650 MHz due to potential interference Federal operations.
- (8) The designated point-of-contact to terminate transmissions if interference occurs is Bill Brown at (301) 944-9271.
- (9) Licensee must prior coordination with Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council (AFTRCC) and Mid-Atlantic Area Frequency Coordinator before applying for renewal.
