Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Licensee must prior coordinate testing with other authorized Band 14 operations. Failure to effectively coordinate shall result in FirstNet seeking immediate suspension of the experimental license by the FCC.
- (4) Licensee must accept interference from others operating in the band and must not cause interference to FirstNet operations or those approved to operate in Band 14 per license (i.e. AT&T testing or public safety entities authorized to operate on Band 14).
- (5) Licensee POC shall submit a "Stop Buzzer" contact to FirstNet at peter.tomczak@firstnet.gov upon authorization issuance with "kill switch" authority; license POC agrees to immediately cease operations on Band 14 if notified of any interference concerns until any issues are resolved.
- (6) Licensee agrees that this license may be subject to further review by the FCC and possible re-coordination with FirstNet.
