- (4) Licensee must get consents from Advanced Wireless Service licensees in the applicable geographic areas, and coordinate with Fixed Microwave licensees to prevent interference with fixed point to point paths and with possible Temporary Fixed/Mobile point-to-point paths.
- (5) During transmission, aircraft shall NOT exceed the altitude 0050, AGL.

Special Conditions:

- (6) Operation is NOT permitted using the frequency band 1755-1850 MHz due to potential interference to Federal operations.
