Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) T-47G will be used to verify the operations of transponder modes 1, 2,3A and C on multiple aircrafts. Mode C response must indicate an altitude below sea level or above 90K feet if the unit is not directly connected via cable to the receiver or operated under a hood with a dummy load.
- (4) Operation is subject to prior coordination with FAA Southwest Regional Office, 4400 Blue Mound, Fort Worth, TX 76193-7246, ATTN: Frequency Management Office: PH: 817-740-3237.
- (5) Testing of mode 4 is not authorized.
- (6) A unit must be operated under a hood with a dummy load or directly connected via cable to the aircraft receiver to reduce free space radiation.
