Pursuant to Condition 5 of the Special Temporary Authority ("STA") granted to The Boeing Company ("Boeing") on July 12, 2002 (Call Sign WC2XVE, File No. 0215-EX-ST-2002), Eutelsat SA ("Eutelsat") hereby certifies that it has notified all operators of co-frequency satellites within ± 6 degrees longitude of each of Eutelsat Atlantic Bird 2 and Eutelsat II-F4 that these Eutelsat satellites are authorized points of communication for certain aircraft earth stations that will test and demonstrate Connexion by Boeing two-way aeronautical mobile satellite services.
