Dear Frequency Management Services,

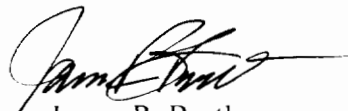
This refers to application, File No. 0059-EX-RR-2005, for Experimental Radio Station KA2XYG.
