Message:

The Mobile Broadband System is a transportable wireless communications system whose purpose is to provide a link between a remote user and terrestrial communications infrastructure.

For example, the satellite link using the license for which application is pending may be combined with a terrestrial-based wireless local-area-network (LAN) link that utilizes unlicensed spectrum bands in order to provide the remote user with the desired connectivity. In this case, a remote user would be linked to the earth station via the wireless LAN and the earth station would be linked via satellite to a gateway.
