Dear Mr. Kennedy:

In answer to your questions concerning Boeing's experimental license applications for T&C earth stations at Canoga Park, California (file #0061-EX-PL-2003) and Littleton, Colorado (file #0062-EX-PL-2003):

- 1) The Exhibit for each application mentions both earth stations because the Canoga Park and Littleton facilities are eventually to be operated as integral parts of the SPACEWAY satellite system control segment, once the first SPACEWAY North American satellite is launched.
- 2) The 13-m antenna at Canoga Park, as well as the 8-m antennas at Canoga Park and Littleton, are to be tested on-site because they are too large to be tested at our antenna ranges and because they have already been assembled on-site. Testing will be performed through transmitting to and receiving signals from satellites, at the respective earth stations. The satellites to be used for this testing could include any US-licensed satellites, along with any satellites on the Commission's Permitted Space Station List, with Ka-band payloads.
