Engineers at Mesa, AZ Antenna Range D have lowered their RF power emission requirements significantly to seek additional spectrum authorization. This application for modification adds two items to the RF equipment inventory. There are no changes in location, antennas, heights or azimuths.

In addition to the military contract work already filed with the FCC as a condition of the existing license, Boeing is requesting authorization for research and development work to support Boeing funded projects.

Since this license has been granted and work conducted at the facility, there has been no RF interference issues reported to Boeing Frequency Management or staff at the Antenna Range. As noted on the license, coordination activities with other agencies continue.
