Dear Rex D. Miller,

This refers to application, File No. 0066-EX-ML-2004, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. Your application is asking for authorization from 30 MHz to 18 GHz at varying power levels. These powers are at a sufficient level to require coordination with both private and government operations in the requested bands. The modification request diverts significantly from the original authorization and lacks documentation of prior coordination with licensees in sensitive bands such as aviation or commercial bands. The broad nature of your request does not allow us to proceed any further with your application. If you still wish to pursue this request please prior coordinate with the appropriate entities for each band requested according to the table of allocation in Part 2.106 of the FCC rules.
