Dear Frequency Manager,

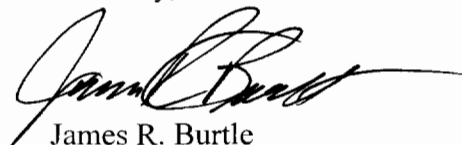
This refers to application, File No. 0158-EX-ST-2005, for Experimental Radio Station WC9XDG.
