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1. Identification of the specific information for which confidential treatment is sought:

The information which requires confidential treatment is contained in the Confidential Items document, the SBE Coordination Indiana document, the SBE Coordination Indiana 2 document, and the SBE Coordination Missouri document. Each of these documents contains proprietary technical information, which should not be disclosed to the public.

2. Identification of the Commission proceeding in which the information was submitted or a description of the circumstances giving rise to the submission:

Boeing is submitting this request to the FCC to protect competitive and proprietary research and development.

3. Explanation of the degree to which the information is commercial or financial, or contains a trade secret or is privileged:

Boeing is submitting this request to the FCC to protect competitive and proprietary research and development. This information has commercial and financial value to Boeing.

4. Explanation of the degree to which the information concerns a service that is subject to competition:

Boeing is submitting this request to the FCC to protect competitive and proprietary research and development. Releasing this information will harm Boeing's competitiveness.

5. Explanation of how disclosure of the information could result in the substantial competitive harm:

Boeing is submitting this request to the FCC to protect competitive and proprietary research and development. Disclosure of this information will taint the competitive process.

6. Identification of any measures taken by the submitting party to prevent unauthorized disclosure:

Boeing has classified the information as "Boeing Proprietary" which makes the information available only to a small selection of people within Boeing and only on a need to know basis. Boeing's internal processes to protect information have been applied.
